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Frequently Asked Registration Questions

Do I need to have a valid email address?

SFIAB is built around the concept that each participant has a valid and working email address, all participants are encouraged to get a valid email account. This account may be obtained by several ways here are a few:

Go to hotmail.com and click the signup button then follow the onscreen instructions.

Go to Yahoo Mail and click the signup link then follow the onscreen instructions

You may be able to get one from your regional science fair as well

You should check with your school/school board for any restrictions on accessing email from the schools network

Alternatively, the participant can ask a relative or friend permission to use their email address just for the science fair. A valid email address is used to send your registration number to you as well as a communications tool for fair committee members and the participant..

What if the student is absolutely unable to get access to an email account?

The school will have to invite the participant and were an email address or login name is requested you will enter a login name. It does not have to be in proper email format. Once the invitation is complete the teacher will provide the login name and registration number to the participant.

What if I do not have access to a computer at home?

No one will be turned away because of a lack of computer access. Contact the regional fair registrar and request a paper registration form.
